Choose one of the following options:

1) Research a Hispanic poet.

- ✓ Choose a poem. Please bring the literary piece to class.
- ✓ Give a brief biography of the author during your presentation.
- ✓ **Be ready to recite the poem in Spanish!**
- ✓ During your presentation relate what you think the poet is talking about.
- ✓ **Except for reciting the poem, you may use English in your presentation!**

2) Make your own alphabet book!

- ✓ Each letter must be represented with a picture.
- ✓ Write the word in Spanish that correlates with the picture and letter.
- ✓ Be creative and make sure your work is neat and well developed.
- ✓ Be ready to present orally in class.

3) You may write a 100 word essay, in Spanish, about your summer.

- ✓ You may use the present tense to describe what you did.
- ✓ Check for spelling and grammatical forms, like conjugation of verbs and proper use of adjectives.
- ✓ Your essay must be typed, double spaced and use 12 font.
- ✓ Be ready to turn in a typed copy.
